When using CINCH, Click on the "Help" button at any time for Help. This can be found in the footer at the bottom of the CINCH screen

#### Other features

Share

The share button allows you to share CINCH results via email, Facebook, twitter, or Digg

Print

The print button allows you to print a general results list (group names) or individual records

Expor

The export button allows you to export complete records in Excel format

#### **Update process**

- We run an update check every year
- Request Changes to Entry

  Groups can update their own records using the Request

  Changes to Entry button at the bottom of their record if this is completed by someone
  else the CINCH Administration staff and the current contacts on the record are made
  aware of this

#### **Community Information CHristchurch directory**

The **CINCH** directory contains approximately 6000 listings of community clubs and organisations in Christchurch and surrounding districts. CINCH covers a wide range of subject listings grouped under 12 main categories. CINCH has:

- Google maps
- Print, Share and Export functions
- A Mobile version of the website

Users can also add / update their details directly using the update forms.

## How to search

## **Finding information in CINCH** Advanced Search Searches in the CINCH directory are **keyword** searches Type the word(s) you wish to search for and press the **Enter** key or click the **Search** button e.g. Addington raceway The most relevant results will be listed first followed by other listings that contain one or more of your search words. **Advanced Search** The Advanced Search allows you to search for keywords and select relevant Subject & Locations using dropdown menus. E.g. Rugby could be entered as a keyword and Aranui selected in the Locations Alternatively you can select Subject(s) and Location(s) e.g. Educational groups - High schools Educational groups High schools Location(s): Linwood & Bromley (multiple locations can be selected using the Add) Locations Linwood Bromley Entry Type: It is best to leave this on All to ensure your search is completed across the whole directory. Fields Field(s) can be individually searched e.g. Name, Description, Email Use this only if you know the keywords definitely exist **Field Name** Search Value Name Add another

#### **Browsing**

A-Z

Alphabetical list of subject terms

Browse by subjects


Browsing the directory using the A-Z is particularly useful to get an idea of just how many listings there are. It is also good if you are not completely sure of the spelling of some words or even what you are interested in.

### Main Categories

Citizen and consumer Educational groups Occupational training
Community groups Health and welfare Personal development
Community studies Home and family Sports and recreation

Every record in the directory is listed under at least one of the categories. These categories link to narrower subject terms
