





Small Funding Grants for Pacific Initiatives

In 2019/20, Pegasus Health (Charitable) Ltd is making available a modest amount of funding to support Pacific communities develop, set up and pilot new initiatives - classes, groups and programmes - that encourage regular physical activity and promote active lifestyles. The distribution of these funds is managed by the Physical Activity Small Grants Committee, which includes the: Pacific Health Manager, Pacific Health Promoter (Lifestyles Team), Programme Coordinator (Practice Support) and Active Canterbury Network Coordinator.

Criteria:

Applications approved by the committee will:

- 1. Be a NEW class, group and/or programme
- 2. Promote the benefits of physical activity and active lifestyles
- 3. Have measurable outcomes
- 4. Not have any other corporate sponsorship/funding which would conflict with Pegasus Health's Commercial Bias Policy
- 5. Be under \$1000 expenditure
- 6. Be submitted by a church, trust or organisation supporting Pacific communities
- 7. Be evaluated using the reporting template provided

Process for submitting an application:

- All sections of the application form must be completed.
- Submitters can either complete a hard copy **OR** an online application form (see link below).
- Applications must be received between 1 October and 15 November 2019.
- Applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application by **Friday 29 November 2019**.
- Activities must be delivered by 30 June 2020.
